HELPFUL STEPS HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

- 1. Find a good time for your Bible reading
- 2.Pray before reading your Bible that God shall give you quick understanding
- 3. Never rush reading your Bible like a newspaper or novel. N.B. Read it attentively.
- 4. Mark the verses and take notes as you are reading your Bible, underline the quotations which sound special and important to you, continue the passage and read it all.
- 5.Follow the word you read: During the reading of the verses, God may touch your heart concerning your past or your present life to be corrected. Don't hesitate to repent and change.
- 6.Share what you read with others, e.g. friends, relatives, wife, husband, co-workers, children. What you gain from the reading share in public for the sake of the Gospel. (2 Timothy 4: 1-5)
- 7. Meditate and live in the word of God. Many believers read the Bible and forget the instructions. Remember the word of God: "Study this book of the law continually, meditate on it day and night so you may be sure to obey all that is written in it. Only then you will succeed." (Joshua 1:8 NLT) Therefore meditate and remember throughout the day the word that the Lord has spoken to you and apply it to your daily life conduct.
- 8. Read daily in the morning and in the evening.
- 9.Each week has a memory verse, try to memorize the quotation
- 10.Every month has a key note as the main topic for the monthly meditation.

2016 The Year of LOVE

YOU SHALL LOVE **THE LORD YOUR GOD** WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND; AND **YOUR NEIGHBOR** AS **YOURSELF.** Luke 10:27



This is the major statement about love in the Bible. Here in Luke it is a scribe who quotes these words to Jesus Who asked him about what is written in the Law. In the book of Matthew 22:37-39 Jesus Himself declares this love commandment and explains that the first (love the Lord your God) is the greatest but the second (love your neighbor as yourself) is like the first. And in Mark 12:30-31, Jesus adds "There is no other commandment greater than these".

This three-part love commandment is not new. The Lord Jesus reminds the hearers of two passages in the Old Testament: Deuteronomy 6:5, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might", and Leviticus 19:18b, "you shall love your neighbor as yourself; I am the Lord." Apostle Paul shortened the commandment in Galatians 5:14 "For the whole Law is fulfilled in one word, in the statement, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." indicating that loving your neighbor as yourself is the correct expression of the love for God. In other words, if you want to show your love for Jesus, let your neighbor feel your actions of love. Apostle John said: If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. (1 John 4:20) And, "let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth." (1 John 3:18) Love therefore is not a passive "feeling" only; love is expressed in actions. However, love is of course a very strong emotion. It is the total acceptance of the other coupled with the strong desire of the other's presence and the willingness to sacrifice/ give for the other. Yet it is more than romantic enthusiasm. Many "fall in love" without knowing the other person and after some time the love is gone. This is not real love. God is love. There is no greater lover than He. Strange enough, this short-time love happens even to Him: Matthew 13: 20-21 "The one on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; yet he has no root in himself, but is temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he falls away." People hear God's word of His great love for us, but at the uncomfortable time they desert Him. Let us stick to love. Let us continue to love God and to love our neighbor as ourselves. God deserves our love. And concerning our neighbor we must consider that love is a decision and a commandment and a covenant. We have no other choice than to love. If God so loves us, we also must love. Any other thing would be unjust. God gave His only Son to die for us- this is the ultimate expression of His love. Jesus loves us so much that he gave His life voluntarily when we did not even know Him: We love, because He first loved us. (1 John 4:19)

James the brother of Jesus is calling this commandment the "royal law": "If, however, you are fulfilling the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing well.(James 2:8). It was given by the King (Jesus), and it has an outstanding

position and meaning. Romans 13: 9 says that all commandments are summed up in this one: For this, "You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet," and if there is any other commandment, it is summed up in this saying, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Although this is an old commandment, Jesus yet established a new one when he spoke to His disciples in John 13: 34: "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. Jesus calls this "His commandment" in John 15: 12, "This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.", and in verse 17: " This I command you, that you love one another." So we have no other choice, it is a command. While the quotations from the law of Moses refer to all men, Jesus' commandment refers particularily to the believers. Love among Christians is essential for the expansion of His kingdom: By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another. (John 13:35) Do you love other Christians?

How, then, can we obey His commandment?

1. *Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, all your mind.* Every human being needs love and needs to love. Why don't you direct your attention, your affection, your trust directly to Your Maker, to the most desirable person in the whole universe-to Jesus Christ? For He is the LORD your GOD! If man or woman, parent or child, or any other rejects your love and disappoints you and hurts you, Jesus will never do that! He even needs your love as you need His. When you love Him you are responding correctly to His eternal and immortal love declaration to you. You cannot make a mistake. Tell Him often that you love Him. Let Him into your heart, let your soul be tuned towards Him, that is, let all your emotions be led by Him. If you give your soul to a man or to the devil or to the world you will loose it or be disappointed at least. With Jesus your soul is safe. "With all your strength"- Paul said "Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, serve the Lord." (Romans 12:11) Praise and worship Him with your voice, with your body as David did; don't be late or absent in church, don't prefer wordly activities to His house, preach the Gospel to others, pray hard. "With all your mind"- let all your thoughts be transformed by His word. Think about Him, meditate on His word. Let the Word be the guideline for all your life.

2. *and your neighbor*. Well, you can't worship your neighbor, but you can serve your neighbor. Your neighbor(s) can be your relatives and friends, but also strangers (Luke 10:30-37). We must consider all mankind as our neighbor. Hospitability and willingness to give, to share with others are very important: we share food, clothes, time, money, we weep with others and rejoice with others. Don't be stingy and do not think only of your family. People have entertained angels without knowing it: Hebrews 13:2. Jesus will judge us according to how we have treated our fellow human beings: Matthew 25:31- 47 We are told to be friends to others and to speak the truth in love. (Ephesains 4:15)

3. *as yourself*. Do you love yourself? Some do, others do not. Maybe you have a complex or some infirmities which make it hard for you to accept yourself. God Who is love encourages us to love ourselves as well. You shall not love somebody MORE than yourself, but AS yourself. You are already loved by God, you can now care for yourself, be kind to yourself. This implies self-forgiveness, mercy on yourself, providing good things for yourself, and not doing harm to your body or to your soul. Be strong and courageous!

May the Almighty God continue to reveal His goodness and mercy and His great love to all of us. In Jesus' precious name. Amen

1 Corinthians 13



If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have *the gift of* prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. And if I give all my possessions to feed *the poor*, and if I surrender my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing.

Love is patient, love is kind *and* is not jealous; love does not brag *and* is not arrogant, does not

act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*, does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Love never fails; but if *there are gifts of* prophecy, they will be done away; if *there are* tongues, they will cease; if *there is* knowledge, it will be done away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part; but when the perfect comes, the partial will be done away. When I was a child, I used to speak like a child, think like a child, reason like a child; when I became a man, I did away with childish things. For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face; now I know in part, but then I will know fully just as I also have been fully known.

But now faith, hope, love, abide these three;

but the greatest of these is love.

Testimony of God's love

I grew up in the atheist society of the GDR. We were taught in the school that there is no God; those who believe in God are fools. Still a child, I saw in a TV program a church interior with a crucifix. Feeling pain in hands and feet, I asked my parents: "WHO IS THIS? And why did He have to die like that?" They said something of a legislative error. After the collapse of the GDR my niece was born, and I was chosen to be her God- mother. For that function I needed to be baptised. I received no instruction or preparation, but went to the ceremony with a feeling of awe, and when the pastor asked me a question in which the name of Jesus Christ appeared I wholeheartedly answered with "yes". Psalms 8:4 was chosen for my baptism "Who is man that you should remember him? And who is the son of man that you are mindful of him?"

Indeed, God remembered me 5 years later. I had begun to study at the university of Potsdam and travelled to Russia to spend one semester abroad. Meanwhile I had followed the sinful course of life, having no orientation and perspective. There, in the city of Smolensk I began to attend Calvary Chapel, a missionary branch of an American church. For two months I listened to the Gospel and enjoyed the company of young believers who were full of love for Christ and for one another. My heart was being changed during that time. I learned to forgive. On the 27th of May 1999 I sat in the church, and the service began with a song that I

church, and the service began with a song that I knew already by heart:

"White as snow, white as snow, though my sins were as scarlet. Lord I know, Lord I know that I'm clean and forgiven, through the power of your blood, through the wonder of your love, through faith in you I know that I can be white as snow."

While they were singing, I suddenly became aware of my condemnation because of my sins. I saw myself falling from heaven with the terrible understanding: "There is a holy God, and I am



lost. No one can save me." As I was thinking the latter, I saw a hand coming, a big one, and I fell into that hand. Simultaneously, a voice said: I CAN. Upon that voice, I opened my eyes. There, at the altar, I saw Calvary, as it happened 2000 years ago. The others did not see it. As I watched I was brought closer to the Cross as with a zoom. Jesus was on that cross, suffering terribly. I could feel His pain- once again. I realized that there is more to that. His pain was different. He did not suffer like other people. "This is the Son of God."- My heart understood the connection to God His Father. He looked so glorious, so full of love. He was winning although He was dying. In His death He thought of you and me and "loved us to the end". He died of love. Love killed Him. Then I was directly standing before the cross. He looked at me. When His eyes found mine, He called my name and said "This is for you!" I broke down and wept.

Two days later, on Friday 29th of May 1999, during a house meeting they prayed for my journey back to Germany. When they did, I had another vision: the cloudy sky opened and light broke through, but the light was brighter than the sun, and again I heard the voice of God, mighty and all- encompassing, saying: "I love you. I have ever loved you and I will always love you." This word filled me as it is written in Romans 5: 5. I had to answer God, and thus I spoke my first public prayer- in russian. After that I realized that these are my brothers and sisters, my true family, since God is my true Father and that the Bible is His book.

I thank the Lord Jesus Christ for bringing me near, for saving me, for guiding me to the end. He did the same for all of us, for you, too. He loves you just in the same way. Why don't you answer Him today?


