HELPFUL STEPS HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

- 1. Find a good time for your Bible reading
- 2. Pray before reading your Bible that God shall give you quick understanding
- 3. Never rush reading your Bible like a newspaper or novel. N.B. Read it attentively.
- 4. Mark the verses and take notes as you are reading your Bible, underline the quotations which sound special and important to you, continue the passage and read it all.
- 5. Follow the word you read: During the reading of the verses, God may touch your heart concerning your past or your present life to be corrected. Don't hesitate to repent and change.
- 6. Share what you read with others, e.g. friends, relatives, wife, husband, co-workers, children. What you gain from the reading share in public for the sake of the Gospel. (2 Timothy 4: 1-5)
- 7. Meditate and live in the word of God. Many believers read the Bible and forget the instructions. Remember the word of God: "Study this book of the law continually, meditate on it day and night so you may be sure to obey all that is written in it. Only then you will succeed." (Joshua 1:8 NLT) Therefore meditate and remember throughout the day the word that the Lord has spoken to you and apply it to your daily life conduct.
- 8. Read daily in the morning and in the evening.
- 9. Each week has a memory verse, try to memorize the quotation
- 10. Every month has a key note as the main topic for the monthly meditation.

2017 The Year of FREEDOM

So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. (John 8:36)

Free? From what?

Free indeed, Jesus said.

The Bible says: The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning.

The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work. (1 John 3:8)

The passage says that the devil has been sinning from the beginning. This means that he is still doing it, he is still sinning. He has not stopped. From the beginning of history the devil's work is sin. On the contrary, man was created to be like God, without sin, yet he fell into temptation and lost his fellowship with God and his holy nature. All mankind is trapped in the sinful nature, for we all inherited it from Adam and Eve. There is noone excluded: "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23) Apostle Paul said, that our transgression may not be like Adam's (Romans 5:14), that is, our own individual sins may differ, yet they originate from the same corrupted sinful inner being. The devil- the originator of sin- keeps people captivated in their sins. There are obvious sins and less obvious sins. Addictions, for instance, show the whole misery of captivity. People get into drugs, alcoholism, cigarette smoking rather randomly, often after being introduced by friends; and then in a slow process they get firmly fixed into a corset of addiction. One can hear them say, "I'd like to get out of this, but I can't." And that is very true. It is like the grip of an anaconda snake. It is a huge python that moves slowly, but strategically. This is the description of the snake's behaviour:

Anacondas are not venomous, and do not kill their prey with bites alone. Rather, they will bite their prey and then wrap their massive bodies around the prey. As their prey is exhaling, anacondas will squeeze their bodies tighter around their prey eventually causing suffocation. This process is called constriction. After this constriction process, anacondas will begin to swallow their prey whole. Their jaws are held together by stretchy ligaments, allowing their mouths to open to sizes much larger than the initial size of their heads. ¹

Not by chance that the Bible says that the devil is "the ancient serpent" that was in the garden of Eden, but by now he has developed into a huge dragon: *The great dragon* …- that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads the whole world astray. (Revelation 12:8)

The devil acts just like that snake. He is lying in wait, approaching quietly, unhearable... many people, when asked, say that they do not believe in the devil. No

wonder. As the prey of the anaconda becomes unconscious and helpless and strenghtless, so man's mind gets darkened and blinded by the devil. They no longer know what they are doing. The devil tells people constantly that there is no God and there is no devil. You will find out when speaking to the unsaved. People are unconsciously trapped in their sinful lifestyle and cannot possibly liberate themselves. As the victim of the snake is ultimately lost, so is a human being ultimately lost if he cannot escape the grip of the devil.

The sins he or she is committing led by the greatest sin of unbelief will lead inevitably to hell. When the devil rebelled against God in the beginning, he was defeated by the archangel Michael and his angels, and the devil and his angels on his side were thrown unto the earth. They were in heaven before, but because Satan wanted to take God's position, he was flung out and can never return. The Lord Jesus explained that as a punishment a place was prepared for him, that is the place of eternal fire. (Matthew 25:41) The devil therefore is very angry and jealous of mankind, because they can be saved, can enter heaven, the place that he lost. And because of this very reason he is pursueing mankind in order to drag them along with him into the eternal fire. Don't be deceived, your life is eternal, when you die, only your body becomes dust, but your soul does not die. Your soul, which is your real self, only leaves the body. You will go out and then go to your eternal home. There are only two places possible- heaven or hell. Heaven is the place where there is no sin any longer, a holy place, where the Almighty dwells and the holy angels and the righteous people who have died previously. It is the place where

they receive their reward for their good and holy deeds, where true martyrs are comforted, where believers see Him in whom they believed, where the saved are enjoined to their Saviour. Do you fit to be in that society?

Or hell- a place where every abomination, every atrocity, every small and great sin continue to be done, but under terrible torment. For it is the place of punishment. Where unbelievers finally know that they should not have laughed at the preachers and should not have criticised the Bible. The Bible is the love and salvation letter of the living God, the Creator of the universe. The Bible is the truth, not the Q'ran, not the book of Mormon, not the Vedes, nor any other literature, though there may be some wisdom in them.



The Bible talks of the Saviour and liberator of mankind- Jesus Christ, Who is in Himself the personification of the Almighty God- the spiritual God made visible in flesh. Noone has more compassion, and more power than the Lord Jesus Christ. Just like the snake is stronger than the victim so Satan is stronger than man. But there is good news. There is Someone who is yet stronger than the devil. The devil has power but there is One who has ALL POWER. He is Jesus who said "all power in heaven and on earth has been given unto me!"(Matthew 28:18) He himself carried our sins in his own body to the cross and died, and because He died yet without committing sin, He conquered the devil. He became the perfect sacrifice for sins- a sinless human being. Therefore God rose him

from the dead. By so doing the devil lost his power over death. This power is presently and forever in the hands of the crucified and risen Lord Jesus. Therefore, call upon Him if you know that something is too strong for you. Nothing and noone can keep those captive who are freed by Jesus, for only Jesus can loosen the bonds, take off the chains, and break the yoke of addiction, the yoke of "I cannot do it". Try it today and experience the mighty Saviour!


God's promises:
