Our aims of publishing this booklet are


- to encourage our readers with the word of God

- 7. Meditate and live in the word of God: most believers read the Bible and forget the instructions. Remember the word of God to the Israelites: "Study this book of the law continually, meditate on it day and night so you may be sure to obey all that is written in it. Only then you will succeed." (Joshua 1:8) NLT Therefore meditate and remember throughout the day the word that the Lord has spoken to you and apply it to your daily life conduct.
- 8. Read daily in the morning and in the evening.
- 9. Each week has a memory verse, try to memorize the quotation
- 10.Every month has a key note as the main topic for the monthly meditation.
